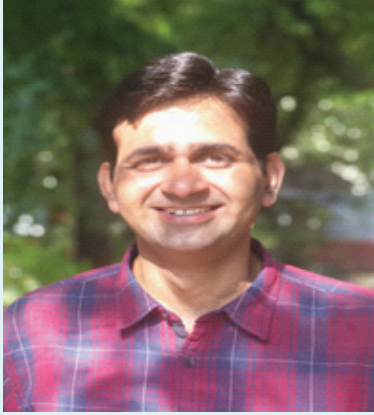

He has over 18 years of teaching and administrative experiences in India's reputed institutions.

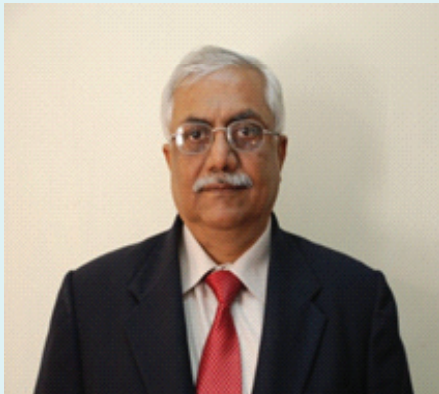

Programmes Offered

The Centre for Vocational Studies offers three under-graduate Programmes:

- Bachelors of Business Administration (BBA)
- Bachelors of Computer Application (BCA)
- Bachelors of Information Technology (B.Sc. IT)

The programmes are affiliated to Ranchi University, Ranchi and are three years full-time under-graduate programmes offered under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The objectives of these Vocational programmes are to create industry ready professionals possessing excellent academic achievements, who are responsive towards dynamic socio-economic and organizational challenges of the modern day businesses and industries, and have the right skill set to exhibit high levels of performance in the global setup.

The Curriculum is designed by the University and effectively deployed by the Centre. The entire curriculum is covered under six semesters, each of six-month duration. The first semester introduces the programme to the students whereas the rest Semesters make the student delve into the depths of the programmes.

The BBA students are offered specialization in their final year, during the last two semesters, in core functions of business administration, viz. Finance, Marketing and Human Resource Management. The BCA and B.Sc. IT programmes are specialized programmes covering different contemporary computer operating systems and languages during the semesters.

The field of study for all programmes offered is dynamic in nature and new developments keep popping up from time to time. The Centre ensures special courses and activities based on the latest developments in the field of study of these programmes to keep its students updated on the developments. Industry driven Curriculum

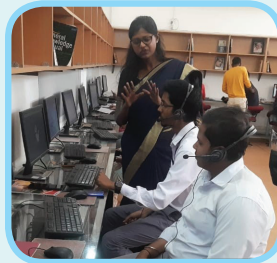
Curriculums of the programmes offer flexibility in learning. The students are free to opt for electives of their choice from the list of electives notified by the University. The Curriculum is as par with the requirements of industry and job market and is approximately parallel to the curriculum of all leading institutions of the Country. Industry and business exposure

Certification courses

We are providing certification courses for the student's overall development. The centre has introduced Certificate Course in Communicative English for BCA/IT and BBA students. The course objective is to enhance the learner's communication skills by giving adequate exposure to Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing Skills and the related skills. This course consists of both theory and practical classes.

The centre has also introduced a few more certification courses in the ensuing academic session. The Certification Course in Cyber Security is been introduced to our students to enhance their skills in computer science. They will learn how to protect and defend computer system and

networks from cyber security attacks. Not only the theory classes but the students are also been provided with hands-on session.

The centre has also provided Certification Course in Cloud Computing to the BCA and IT students. These courses help the students to bridge the gaps between their existing skill sets and the requirement of the industry. The course will certify the students the knowledge and skills required to understand standard cloud methodologies; to implement, maintain, and deliver cloud technologies (e.g., network, storage, and virtualization technologies); and to understand aspects of IT security. The centre offers some more certification courses like Marsal Art, Yoga, Office executive etc.

Mentorship

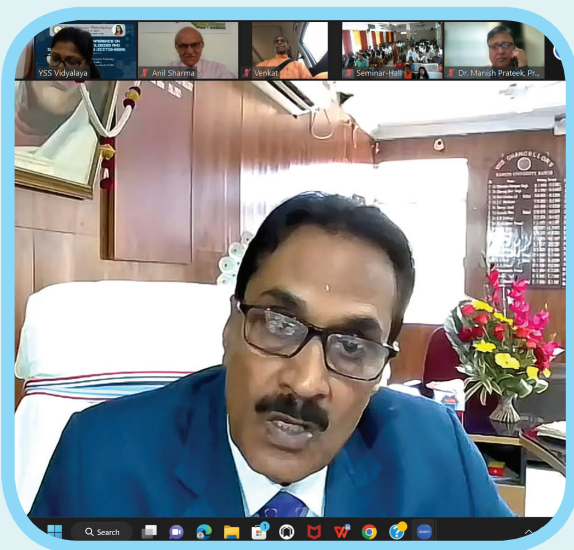
science. The views expressed and explored on this platform by the resource persons and paper presenters made the audience rethink ideas which we cling on to unthinkingly in our day-to-day life.

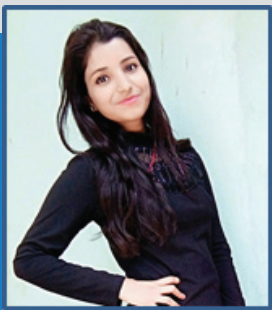

Video lectures were uploaded on the Mahavidyalaya's official YouTube channel. The links of the video lectures were also shared on the e-learning platform on the institution's website.

The Vocational departments of the Mahavidyalaya have their class wise WhatsApp groups wherein the students of that particular class are participants. The teachers share the links of the live virtual classes with their students well in advance so that the students may make it convenient to attend the class from their home. Regular tests, quiz, discussions, etc, are conducted to monitor the learning progress of the students. We have also introduced the Google Classroom to them for sharing notes and assignments.

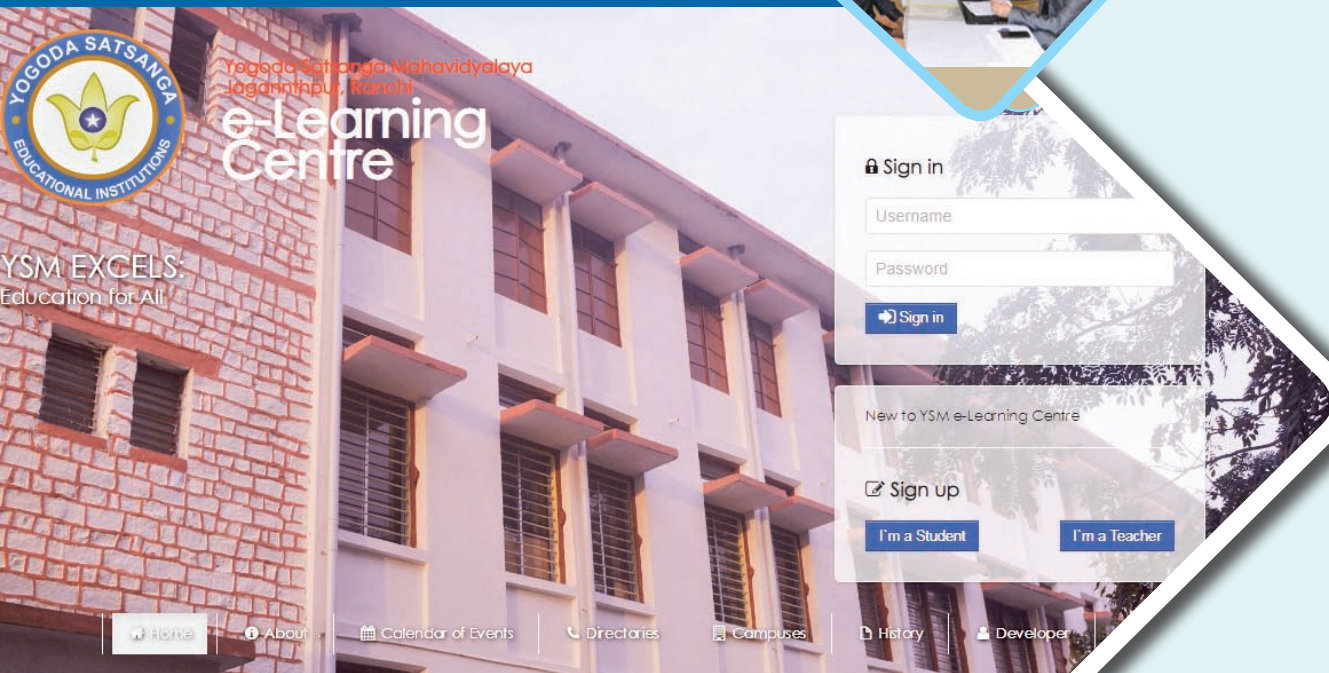

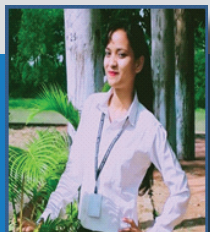

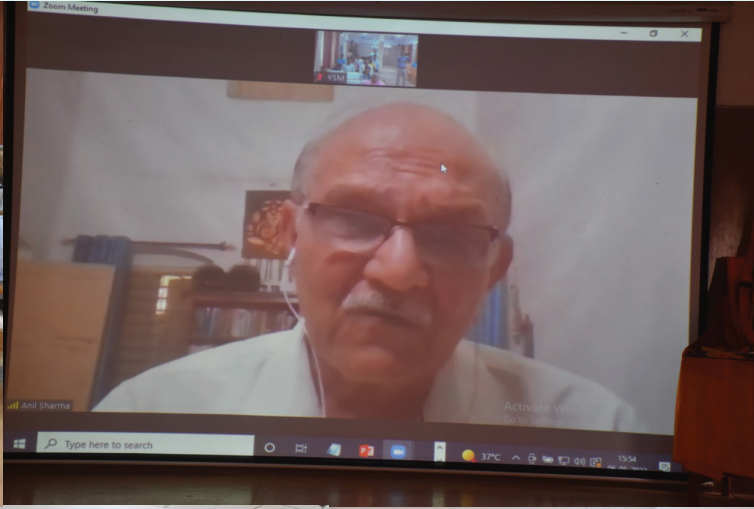

General rules:

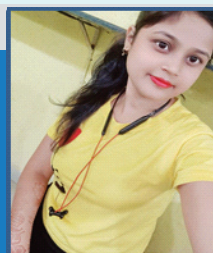
1. Applicants will have to produce original documents for verification as soon as the college reopens.

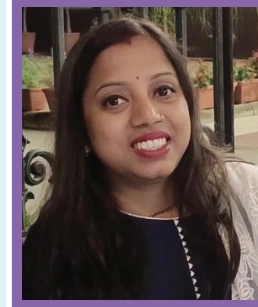

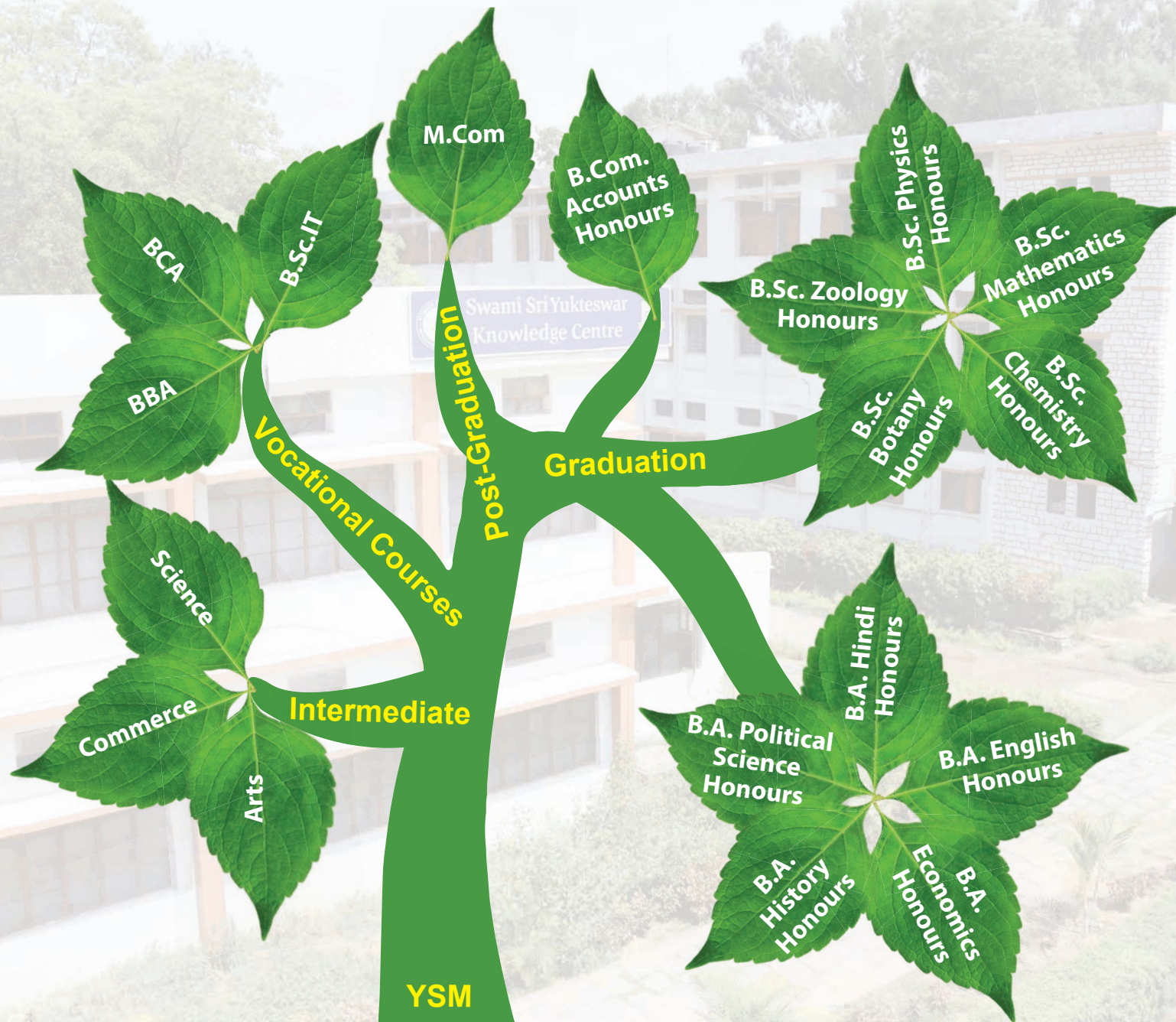
