
a) Lakshya-In-house Journal

C. Intellectual Property Yogoda Satsanga Mahavidyalaya, Ranchi and Itihas Sankalan Samiti, Jharkhand agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. 
3. Departmental Initiatives
