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

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- 1. Library Automation: Central Library, Yogoda Satsanga Mahavidyalaya is a fully equipped lending library that provides information to all who wish to pursue self-learning. It supports the teaching, learning and research activities of the Mahavidyalaya by providing information resources in an appropriate range of formats, suitable study space and facilities for individuals and groups, and efficient user-focused services.
 - (a) <u>Integrated Library Management Software- Koha</u>: KOHA is a full-featured open-source Library Management System. It was initially developed by Katipo Communications Ltd of New Zealand, currently maintained by a team of software providers and library technology staff from around the globe. It is a Customizable Webbased Interface with full MARC support (MARC21 and UNIMARC) and Includes Z39.50 server & client for data interchange.

Central Library, Yogoda Satsanga Mahavidyalaya has been automated with the in-house KOHA integrated library management system since the year 2017 (KOHA - 17.01). Recently we shifted from in-house KOHA to the cloud KOHA (Koha -23.11)



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
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to improve the service quality up to the mark. More than 36000 printed booksare catalogued and barcode enabled in our Central Library.

Picture: - Version of Koha





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







Picture: Staff Interface (Click to Access)


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

Picture: OPAC main page




(f) N-LIST (Remote Access Full Text Database): National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content (N-LIST) is the college component of eShodh Sindhu. It provides access to e-resources to students, researchers and faculty from colleges and other beneficiary institutions through server(s) installed at the INFLIBNET Centre. Central Library, YSM has been a member of N-LIST, INFLIBNET since the year 2017, a college component of an e-ShodhSindhu consortium with access to more than 7783491 full-text e-books and 6435+ e-journals. Presently our Mahavidyalaya has more than 1000 active users in N-LIST.

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- (g) **NDLI and NDLI CLUB**: The National Digital Library of India (NDLI) and NDLI Club are initiatives of Ministry of Education (MOE), Government of India, to enable learners to use NDLI throughout their journey of education while motivating them to contribute actively towards a national knowledge trove. Central Library, YSM is a registered institute of NDLI, IIT, Kharagpur from the year 2017 and users have access to the vastreservoir of e-resources and offers to attend the national and international events on different topics with participation certificate.
- (h) <u>Library account of Users</u>: Central Library's users have their accounts to log in and access features such as circulation details, book renewal services, and purchase suggestion services.
- (i) **Rare Book**: Central Library, YSM has taken an initiative to preserve the rare books of the library digitally through an institutional repository.
- 2. <u>Institutional Repository</u>: Central Library, YSM offered an institutional repository, and a digital archiving facility for the students as well as staff of our Mahavidyalaya to access digitally archived documents.
 - (a) Institutional Repository using DSpace Digital Library Software: Dspace is an open-source repository software that allows to capture, storage, indexing, preservation and distribution of digital material including text, video, audio and data. DSpace provides a way to manage materials and publications in a professionally maintained repository to give them greater visibility and accessibility over time. In the year 2023, Yogoda Satsanga Mahavidyalaya Central Library has installed institutional repository software namely dspace for archiving documents digitally to improve the service quality up to the mark. We are now using the DSpace 6. X version locally to serve the digitally archiving documents among the students as well as ourfaculties.




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

Picture: Previous Year Questions



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

Picture: Newspaper Clipping


