

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

### (c) Yashashvi Scholarship



(a) A student can participate in five events at the most.



Event notice in English(sample)





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

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

### 7. Initiatives of the Electoral Literacy Club

ELC members actively engaged in spreading voter awareness during regular classes throughout September 2023, ensuring a sustained focus on the importance of responsible voting.


### (e) Quiz Competition (4th September 2023):

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
